Garris Landing Public Boat Launch to Close January 4, 2016

Dredging at the Garris Landing public boat launch, Cape Romain National Wildlife Refuge, will begin on Monday, January 4, 2016. Dredging the boat launch at Garris Landing will allow greater ease of access for boaters as it will remove the sediment in the affected waterway. It is anticipated that the launch will re-open on Saturday, January 16th.

The Garris Landing parking area will remain open for visitors who wish to access the pier for fishing or wildlife observation and for visitors traveling to Bulls Island on the Coastal Expeditions concession ferry.
