Bear River Migratory Bird Refuge Brigham City, UT General Bird Survey November 3, 2014

Volunteer Kristin Purdy conducted a general bird survey (non-waterbird) on the refuge on November 3, 2014, recording 20 species. Migrants continue to pass through including a small number (14) of Barn swallows and many (141) American pipits. Winter residents have arrived including American tree sparrows and Rough-legged hawks. Black-capped chickadees in three separate groups foraged in Phragmites stands well out into the marsh.
