Additional Species

The following species have been recorded in the area, or are based on records prior to 1960 (see notations).

Plain-Bellied Watersnake (*Nerodia erythrogaster*) – Record from 1927.

Common Lesser Earless Lizard (*Holbrookia maculata*) – Last known record in 1956

Plains Rat Snake - Has been Verified/recorded in Stafford County

Plain Black Headed Snake - Has been verified in Pratt county.

Milk Snake (*Lampropeltis triangulum*) - Has been documented in Barton County

Spotted Chorus Frog (*Psuedacris clarkii*) - Has been verified in Pratt, Pawnee, and Barton Counties.

Western Narrow Mouth Toad (*Gastrophryne olivacea*) Has been documented in Pratt, Reno, Barton, Rice, and Pawnee counties.

Great Plains Skink (*Plestiodon obsoletus*) - Have been documented in Barton, Rice, Reno, and Pratt Counties.
