1. Fields designated to be corn shall be planted with a un-treated and non-GMO seed. It is the responsibility of the cooperator to purchase and plant the correct seed. There will be corn fields designated as delayed harvest. These fields will be designated Sept. 1. They can be harvested after March 1. *In 2021 8.6 ac. of corn will be delayed harvest. 2022 there will be 10.5 acres and in 2023 8.6 acres will be left for delayed harvest.*
2. The cooperator will use end rows on all crop fields.
3. Hay fields may be cut one time between Aug. 1 and Aug. 15. Bales will be removed immediately. Bales left on the area after Oct. 1 will become the property of the U.S. F & W Service.
4. Acreage figures appearing in the lease may not be the basis for federal farm program payments. It shall be the cooperators responsibility to determine the extent of the farm program benefits that are available.
5. Only herbicides from the pre-approved list may be used.
6. Neonicotinoids are prohibited (treated seed).
7. Insecticide use is prohibited.
8. Fall tillage is not allowed.
