





### Areas Closed to Firearm Discharge

Firearms may **NOT** be discharged within **1/4 mile** of designated public campgrounds, trailheads, waysides, buildings, or the Sterling Highway from the east refuge boundary to the east junction of Skilak Loop Road. **NEW:** You may not discharge within **1/4 mile** of the west shoreline of the Russian River downstream of the Russian River Falls, and **1/4 mile** from the stream banks of the the Kenai River from the east refuge boundary downstream to Skilak Lake and from the outlet of Skilak Lake to the refuge boundary. Firearms may be used in these areas to dispatch animals while lawfully trapping and shotguns may be used for waterfowl and small game hunting along Kenai River. **Target Shooting is NOT allowed ANYWHERE on the Refuge.**
