Bear River Refuge Plans Prescribed Burn to Treat Invasive Plant Phragmites

Bear River Migratory Bird Refuge plans to conduct a late winter prescribed burn on Units 3B and 2B. The planned prescribed burn will remove dead and decadent Phragmites, as part of the Refuge's invasive plants management plan. In order to facilitate this burn, Units 3B and 2B will be dewatered in early to mid-December, which may impact hunting opportunities.

The Wildlife Education Center is located at 2155 W. Forest St., Brigham City, one block west of I-15 at Exit 363. The Center offers interactive exhibits, wetland diorama, 2 miles of outdoor trail, and is open Monday-Friday, 8 a.m.-5 p.m., and Saturdays, 10 a.m.- 4 p.m. The Auto Tour Loop is open daily from sunrise to sunset and is FREE.
