On-going/Year-round opportunities:

- Trail Ranger – Hike our trails and report on condition and visitor activities.
- Visitor Center Attendant – Assist Visitor Services staff in greeting and interacting with the public.
- Interpretation – Educate visitors about the refuge and the natural world.
- Maintenance – May include painting, fixing post and rail, fixing brochure boxes, and helping fix/build program materials.

Seasonal opportunities:

- Environmental Education – Assist staff with environmental education programs for students in grades K-6.
- Invasive Species Removal – Remove a variety of invasive species.
- Seed Collection – Collect seeds from prairie grasses and forbs.
- Special Events – Help with a variety of special events held on the refuge.
- Butterfly/Pollinator Gardens – Help with weeding and maintaining our butterfly/pollinator gardens.
