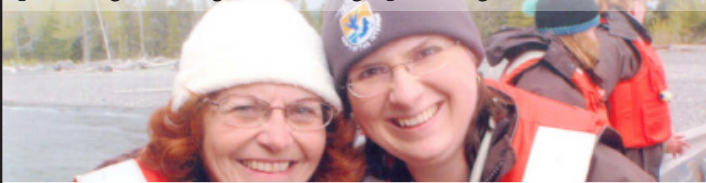


Hands-on fun for preschoolers ages 2-5. Learn all about **Backyard Birds** this month through activities, storytime, snack and a craft.
