

# Hunting



**Modoc National Wildlife Refuge is open to hunting in conjunction with authorized regulations set by the State of California each year. Hunters are required to adhere to the bag and possession limits and any other regulations required for the Northeastern California Zone.**

**Hunting of geese, ducks, coots and snipe is permitted in the designated hunt areas of the refuge. Hunting of any other species is prohibited. The hunting area is open from 90 minutes prior to legal shooting time and closes 60 minutes after the end of legal shooting time on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays. Hunting on the opening weekend is by drawing only. Take a hunting information sheet and brochure about the refuge for all hunting and refuge regulations.**

**Purchase of Federal Duck Stamps make it possible for the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service's National Wildlife Refuges to administer, maintain and develop more protected waterfowl and wildlife areas. At other times of the year these areas can be open to wildlife observation, environmental education, hiking, photography, and refuge wildlife interpretation activities.**
