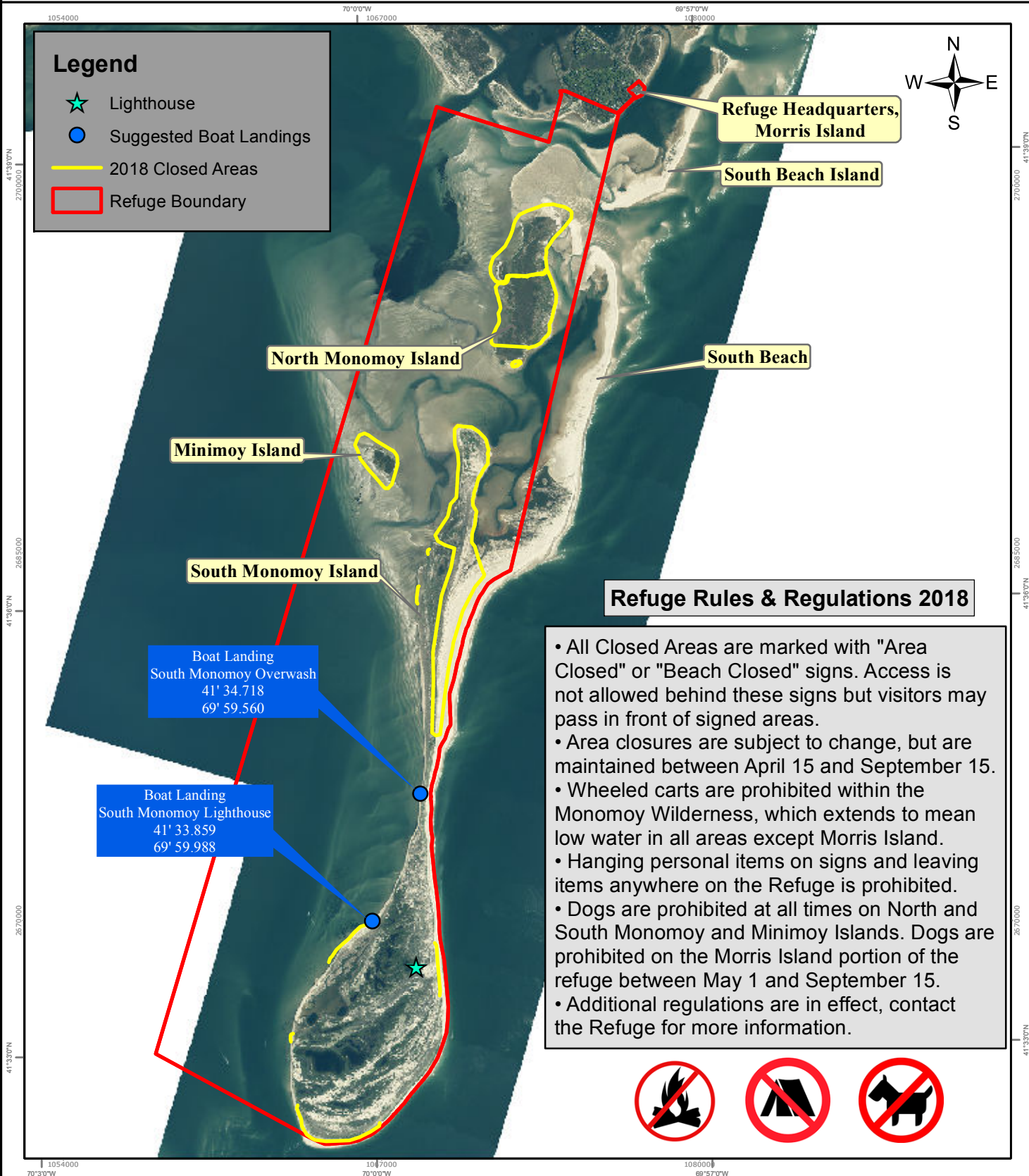




Monomoy National Wildlife Refuge, 2018 Closed Areas Map



Refuge Rules & Regulations 2018

- All Closed Areas are marked with "Area Closed" or "Beach Closed" signs. Access is not allowed behind these signs but visitors may pass in front of signed areas.
- Area closures are subject to change, but are maintained between April 15 and September 15.
- Wheeled carts are prohibited within the Monomoy Wilderness, which extends to mean low water in all areas except Morris Island.
- Hanging personal items on signs and leaving items anywhere on the Refuge is prohibited.
- Dogs are prohibited at all times on North and South Monomoy and Minimoy Islands. Dogs are prohibited on the Morris Island portion of the refuge between May 1 and September 15.
- Additional regulations are in effect, contact the Refuge for more information.
