On Saturday morning, October 18th, 2014 Naval Weapons Station Seal Beach, the Seal Beach National Wildlife Refuge, and the Friends of the Seal Beach National Wildlife Refuge will host a National Public Lands Day event to plant native vegetation.

The Naval Weapons Station Environmental Program has been awarded a grant to restore a 3-acre area with native flowers, shrubs, and grasses in upland habitat adjacent to wetland habitat. This is an area that is being choked out by invasive fennel, thistle, and mustard. This work will create much-needed transitional habitat for native birds, reptiles, mammals and pollinating insects.

The project starts at 8:00 AM and will be completed by noon. If you or your family, friends, or neighbors are interested, please contact the refuge office at 562-598-1024 to make reservations.



2014 National Public Lands Day Event – Directions

From 405 Freeway (north or southbound), exit Seal Beach Blvd. Turn south. Turn left (east) on Westminster Blvd. Make an immediate right into the base.

From Pacific Coast Highway (Hwy 1), turn north on Seal Beach Blvd. Proceed to Westminster Blvd. and turn right (east). Make an immediate right into the base.



NOTE: All drivers are required to have current license, current registration, and proof of insurance to come aboard.

BRING: water bottles (water to refill will be provided), work gloves, hat, sunscreen, closed-toe footwear, signed volunteer agreement (http://www.fws.gov/refuge/Seal_Beach/what_we_do/get_involved.html)

LEAVE AT HOME: tools (they will be provided), weapons, knives, cameras, open-toed footwear (you will not be permitted to work with open-toed shoes or sandals)
