Public Meetings Concerning Proposed Changes to Recreational Fees Rescheduled

Public meetings to consider changes to the Recreational Pass fee structure at the Arthur R. Marshall Loxahatchee and Nathaniel P. Reed Hobe Sound National Wildlife Refuges, which had been postponed due to the partial government shutdown, have been rescheduled. The meetings, originally scheduled for January 22 and 24, have been rescheduled to February 19, 2019 at A.R.M. Loxahatchee NWR and February 20, 2019 at N.P.R. Hobe Sound NWR. Both meetings will begin at 10am. The A.R.M. Loxahatchee NWR meeting will be held in the Visitor Center located at 10216 Lee Road, Boynton Beach, FL 33473. The N.P.R. Hobe Sound NWR meeting will be held in the Visitor Center located at 13640 SE Federal Hwy, Hobe Sound, FL 33455.
