Public comment on compatibility determination for commercial guiding for wildlife observation and photography on the Shiawassee National Wildlife Refuge

A 14-day public comment period begins May 31, 2017 and ends June 14, 2017 on a draft compatibility determination for the commercial guiding of wildlife observation and photography on the Shiawassee National Wildlife Refuge, Saginaw, MI.

The draft compatibility determination is being issued to ensure that commercial guiding of wildlife observations and photography are compatible with the refuge's purpose and mission.

If any use is determined to be "incompatible," it will not be allowed on refuge lands.

The draft compatibility determination will be available for public review and comment at the Shiawassee National Wildlife Refuge Headquarters at 6975 Mower Road, Saginaw, MI 48601 until June 14, 2017 or at the refuge's website at: <https://www.fws.gov/refuge/Shiawassee/>.
