Greetings All,

I know everyone is gearing up for the holidays and hopefully hunting will be a part of those plans.

Here is what we have in the way of habitat right now:

Tule Lake – both sumps are full and hunting well, we have flooded grain in lots 1-4 (along A dike) as well as in the triangle east of the check station. The entire A blinds are flooded and shooting great.

Lower Klamath – we currently have water in 4b, 6a, 6b1 and 7a. We had a little water control malfunction and the ADA blind in unit 5 was closed for a week, it has since been fixed and re-flooded so we are ready to take reservations again. The sanctuary has good water as well. For now all water delivery is complete and what we have flooded now is all we are going to get until further notice.

Pheasant hunting was good the first few weeks of the season but has slowed way down as is typical.

We will be having our last youth hunt the Saturday after Thanks Giving (November 30, 2013).

I would also like to introduce our new enforcement officer Zack. Many of you may have already met him as he has been around learning the ropes of hunting on our Refuge. He's a great guy you guys will like him. If you have any questions or comments for Zack you can contact him at the main office for now, he should have email and a cell set up soon.
