

Old Cedar Bridge Rehabilitation Project to Start January 2012

In preparation for the Old Cedar Avenue Bridge project, the area from the Bluff Trail to Hwy 77 will be rehabilitated. Work will begin the week of January 12, 2015 and will begin around the parking lot and extend southwest towards the Bluff Trail. The trail will remain open, but visitors may experience delays if heavy equipment or chainsaw activity is needed along the trail.

This project includes restoring the habitat to floodplain forest and oak savanna. Woody invasive species, such as buckthorn, will be removed and the dike across Orchard Springs will be rebuilt. The restoration will enhance wildlife habitat as well as provide better wildlife viewing opportunities for visitors. If you have any questions, please call 952/854-5900.
