October Water Conditions at Bear River Refuge

Water conditions continue to improve for waterfowling on the Bear River Refuge. Hunt Units around the auto tour route that are currently at target water levels include 2D and 2C, with 2B filling water. Hunt Units 3B, 1A and 9 are now filling. Hunt Units in the northern portion of Duckville area are at target, including Unit 3—A, I, J and K. Also the Willard Spur Units are filling and launching from the Reeder Canal/Perry boat ramp is possible at this time.

Refuge staff anticipate that conditions will improve at the Handicapped Hunt Blind. Hunters who are interested in reserving this special access blind are encouraged to call for changing water updates.
