Polander Lake Closed Area


- Closed to all migratory bird hunting.
- Closed to all other hunting* and trapping from March 16 until the day after the close of the State duck hunting season.
- * Except spring wild turkey hunting.
- Voluntary Avoidance October 15 to the end of the State duck hunting season.
- Watercraft should use the designated Travel Corridor.

Snyder Lake Electric Motor Area
 Closed year-round to all motorized vehicles and watercraft except watercraft powered by electric motors or non-motorized means.

Denzers Slow, No Wake Area
 From March 16 through October 31, watercraft must travel at slow, no wake speed and no airboats or hovercraft are allowed during this time.
