Guided Walk Rescheduled to Saturday, May 16 at Prime Hook National Wildlife Refuge

“Exploring the Flora and Fauna at Prime Hook in the Late Spring / Early Summer: A Guided Walk,” originally scheduled for Saturday, May 30, 2015, has been cancelled and rescheduled to this **Saturday, May 16 at 10:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.** Please update your calendars accordingly. Join us on a nature hike along some of the trails through the Prime Hook National Wildlife Refuge. Led by an experienced naturalist, the group will not only examine the vegetation along the trail but also check natural signs left by plants and animals that suggest a high diversity of the environment. The group will be exploring open hiking trails that wonder through the refuge for 1 ½ to 2 miles. The outing is well suited for older kids and adults; please do not, however, bring family pets on the walk. Meet at the refuge office.
