



Program Descriptions

Take Aim Archery – Let's go outside and shoot a few arrows. Explore the fun of archery and learn how the Refuge uses hunting to keep the balance in a healthy island ecosystem. **This program is open to anyone ages 7 and older. Equipment is provided.**

Lighthouse talk – For 148 years its light has been a beacon to those coming from near and far. Join us to learn how the story of the Assateague light house is not just a story of the Atlantic Ocean but also a story about you and me.

Refuge Safari – It's time for a Refuge safari! Come explore the residents of the Refuge. Join our staff in the Bateman Visitor Center auditorium to learn more about one of the many different critters that call the Refuge their home.

Plants Prints and paws – Create your own Refuge treasure in this crafty kids program intended to explore the details of the flowers, tracks, and shells of Assateague Island. Stamp and trace nature in your very own take-home nature book.
