

Comment/Idea Form – Rattlesnake Unit (ALE) Access

We're pleased that you are interested in public access to the Rattlesnake Unit of the Hanford Reach National Monument and that you have some ideas about it. You're welcome to submit your comments on this form, by letter, or by email.

When providing us comments, please be specific. Comments like "Provide public access" are not that helpful; that's what we're trying to do. Rather, provide ideas on how best to provide access. Again, be specific, e.g., "there should be at wildflower tours," "there should a hiking trail," or "there needs to be a parking area at the foot of the mountain." And if you can be even more specific, so much the better, e.g., "there should be a year-round hiking trail from [Point A] to [Point B]," or "you should have at least 8 spring wildflower tour that include the mountain top."

Also, since this is scoping process under the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), we'd like to hear your concerns about impacts to the environment (natural, cultural, or human environment) related to access to Rattlesnake Mountain and ALE.
