


San Juan Islands National Wildlife Refuge: Turn Island

- Closed to Public Access

Habitat Management

- Forest and Woodland
Protect and maintain existing areas.
- Savanna, Grassland, and Balds
Manage and/or restore up to 20 acres on Smith and Turn Islands.

Land Status

- Refuge Lands

Designated public use areas and loop trail open to day-use. Turn Island is co-managed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service and Washington State Parks.
