**Hunting Status**

- Archery Hunting for elk, deer, black bear, and grouse (ruffed and sooty) only. Refuge permit required.
- Deer and elk hunting (elk permit only). \*Firearm restriction\*
- Deer and elk hunting. All state regulations apply.
- Regulated goose hunt area. Refuge permit and fee required.
- Waterfowl hunting.
- Refuge lands, tidelands, and water closed to all hunting.
- Clamming

**Refuge Closure Areas**

- Closed to Public
- Closed to Public March 15-September 30
