Employment will last 10 weeks: June 6- August 12, 2016**

Are you between the ages of 15 and 18, and currently enrolled in high school? Would you like to spend your summer working, learning and earning in the outdoors? Would you like a fun job where your efforts make a difference for wildlife and the environment? If you answered **YES** to these questions, the Youth Conservation Corps may be right for you.

To be eligible for the Valle de Oro National Wildlife Refuge YCC Program, applicants must:

- ✓ Be between the ages of 15 (by June 6, 2016) and 19 (not age 19 before August 12, 2016) and currently enrolled in school
- ✓ Be a permanent resident of the United States, its territories or possessions
- ✓ Be available to work 40 hours per week (7:30 a.m.- 4 p.m.), Monday - Friday for the full 8-week period
- ✓ Be able to get to and from Valle de Oro National Wildlife Refuge (7851 2nd street sw)
- ✓ Possess a Social Security card prior to the first working day of the YCC program
- ✓ Have the written permission of a parent or legal guardian to work
