**Compatibility Determination for Video Streaming on Illinois River Refuges  
Available for Review**

The Illinois River National Wildlife and Fish Refuges Complex has prepared a compatibility determination for the use of live, streaming video on the refuge to monitor various wildlife species. The Complex wishes to deploy remote video cameras to capture wildlife imagery and make the imagery available through the internet. The compatibility determination discusses the use of the refuge and its potential impacts.
