Union Slough NWR Issuing Permits for Coyote Hunting

Union Slough National Wildlife Refuge will be issuing Special Use Permits for coyote hunting to be held on the refuge from January 12th through February 21st. This year's hunt will be a general hunt without a drawing or designated hunting zones (although some special regulations will apply). To participate in the hunt, hunters just need to stop by the Refuge Office on or after January 12th to receive a Permit. Office hours are Monday through Friday from 7:30am to 4:00pm. Hunters are encouraged to call the Refuge at 515-928-2523 before coming to assure that a Refuge staff member will be available to assist them.
