# JUNIOR RANGER AT HOME

## Compact Disc "CD" Turtle Craft

Do you have an old CD that skips or is scratched? Don't throw it away - use it to create your very own "CD" Turtle. You can make either a Sea Turtle or a Land (Terrestrial) Turtle.

### You Will Need:

1. Compact Discs - CDs - 2 or 4
2. Scissors
3. Glue
4. Green craft paper
5. Permanent Markers or paint



**1.**

Using non-washable/permanent markers or paint to decorate the "shiny" side of each CD - this is the side with no wording. Make colorful designs for your turtle - try to resemble a turtle's shell. Hint: the bottom of a turtle shell, the plastron, is usually not as elaborate as the top (carapace) shell.



**2.**

Print out the template and trace the shapes for the turtle's head, legs and tail onto the green craft paper.



**3.**

Cut out the shapes and glue them to the non-decorated side of one of the CDs. Hint: Ranger Becky says that you can never have too much glue!

**4.**

Now put glue all over the inside of the same CD and then place the other CD on top. Remember to take a picture and share it with us on Facebook @SoutheastLouisiana
