JUNIOR RANGER AT HOME

Let's Go Camping - Inside!

1. Set up a tent or create a tent out of blankets, pillows and couch cushions.

2. Create a set of binoculars out of TP rolls. You will need: 2 TP Rolls, glue or tape, scissors, decorations (use crayons, markers, stickers, etc.).



- First glue 2 TP rolls together side by side (see picture).
- Use a hole punch or scissors to create a hole on the outside of the binoculars and string a piece of yarn thru to create a strap. Hint: make sure to measure first so the binoculars will fit on and off your head.
- Decorate with crayons, markers, stickers - whatever you have!

3. Go on a nature hike or go birding with your new binoculars. Either out your window or go for a walk in your backyard. Need help identifying birds? Visit audubon.org or ebird.org

4. Make an indoor fire out of TP or Paper towel rolls, egg cartons and tissue paper. You will also need glue and scissors.

- Glue TP rolls to a paper plate in the same way you would stack a wood to make a fire (see picture).
- Cut tissue paper pieces and glue to TP rolls to make fire.
- Cut egg carton rocks and place them around the fire to create a fire ring.



5. Make a meal you would eat while camping. Examples: hot dogs, burgers, one pot meals and s'mores! Eat the meal around your campfire.
