



JUNIOR RANGER AT HOME Compact Disc "CD" Fish Craft

Do you have an old CD that skips or is scratched? Don't throw it away - use it to create your very own "CD" Fish.

You Will Need:

- 2 CDs
- Non-washable markers (permanent markers)
- Scissors
- Glue
- String or ribbon (optional)



1.

Using non-washable/permanent markers decorate the "shiny" side of each CD - this is the side with no wording. Make colorful scales for your fish. Hint: wait to put eyes on until the end so the eyes will match when you glue both CDs together.



2.

Color the fins of your fish from the template pictured. Remember you will need 1 dorsal (top) fin, 1 pelvic (back) fin and 1 caudal (tail) fin - see picture left.



3.

Cut out the shapes and glue them to the non-decorated side of one of the CDs. Hint: Ranger Becky says that you can never have too much glue!

4.

Now put glue all over the inside of the same CD and then place the other CD on top. Next draw eyes and you are done! Remember to take a picture and share it with us on Facebook @SoutheastLouisiana
