JUNIOR RANGER AT HOME

Pine Cone or TP Roll Bird Feeders

Using up a roll of toilet paper means that cardboard tube is ready to become something totally new! Follow these steps to make a birdfeeder for your backyard. No empty TP rolls? Don't worry you can use a pine cone.

You Will Need:

1. TP roll or pine cone
2. Peanut butter or crisco
3. Bird seed
4. String or ribbon
5. Spoon or spatula and a bowl/plate



1. Coat the roll or pine cone with peanut butter or crisco (vegetable shortening), make sure the entire outside of cardboard tube and cone is well covered. Then, wash your hands!

2. After spreading birdseed out in a bowl or plate, roll your cardboard tube or pine cone in the seed. Make sure the seed sticks to cover up the sticky sides.

3. Tie a string or ribbon through your tube or around your pine cone. Outside, hang your new birdfeeder in a nearby tree. Now watch for the birds to visit!
