



STATE ALLIGATOR HUNT MAP

Savannah NWR is NOT open to alligator hunting.

However, some navigable waterways within the refuge boundary are open to alligator hunting, only for those hunters who have obtained a valid state alligator hunting permit. These waterways are marked in yellow and include the Savannah River (in both SC and GA) and Abercorn, Little Abercorn, and Big Collis Creeks (in GA). Alligator hunting is not permitted in the Middle, Back, or Little Back Rivers or any other creeks than those listed above.
