Bulls Island Public Boat Dock Open Effective October 31, 2016

The public boat dock at Bulls Island, Cape Romain National Wildlife Refuge is open to the public effective Monday, October 31, 2016.

The island's service roads and the Middens Trail are clear. A section of the Turkey Walk Trail is open from Beach Road to Summerhouse Ponds impoundments. However, the bay side of the trail remains closed due to damaged boardwalks.
