Job Title	Individual Trails Volunteers- 1 Day project
Qualifications	Participate in Tailgate Safety Session, conducted by Forest Service, 1 hour prior to starting of volunteer project. Willingness to learn about the variety of trails on the Francis Marion National Forest. Good interpersonal and communications skills and desire to work with the public. Must have the physical capability to hike, carry tools and materials. Must possess a valid state driver's license.
Duties and Responsibilities	Assist in operations & maintenance of trail system, including, lopping, shearing, removal of vegetation off trail; picking up litter, cleaning signs, and blazing. Responsible for wearing work boots, work gloves, long sleeve shirt and pants, sun protection clothing such as hats and kerchiefs or sunscreen. Responsible for bringing water and food required for one day of vigorous work. Copy of signed volunteer agreement.
Time commitment	Minimum of 4 hours for a one day project.
