




# Monomoy National Wildlife Refuge, 2013 Closed Areas Map



## Refuge Rules & Regulations 2013

- All Closed Areas are marked with "Area Closed" or "Beach Closed" signs. Access is not allowed behind these signs but visitors may pass in front of signed areas.
- Area closures are subject to change, but are maintained between 15 April and 15 September.
- Camping, hunting (on land), and fires are prohibited on the Refuge.
- Dogs are not allowed on South Monomoy or North Monomoy and Minimoy Islands. On the Morris Island portion of the Refuge, dogs are allowed on a short, hand-held leash.
- Boat landing designations are the safest locations on the Refuge to anchor.
- Motorized vehicles are not allowed on South Monomoy or North Monomoy and Minimoy Islands.
- The destruction, disturbance, or removal of wildlife, vegetation, and government property are prohibited on the Refuge.
- Hanging personal items on closed area signs or leaving of personal items anywhere on the Refuge is prohibited.
- The area in the immediate vicinity of the Monomoy Lighthouse is closed due to construction debris that poses a public safety hazard.
