Public Presentations of New Hunt Plan

Edwin B. Forsythe National Wildlife Refuge announces that there will be two public presentations of the new hunt plan. The first presentation is scheduled for 6:30 p.m. Tuesday, March 20th, at the Lacey Branch of the Ocean County Library, 10 East Lacey Road, Forked River, NJ. The second presentation is scheduled for 6:30 p.m. Wednesday, March 21st at refuge headquarters on 800 Great Creek Road, Oceanville, NJ. The refuge proposes opening new areas for hunting and adding squirrel and turkey seasons. Before a refuge can finalize new plans, it must allow for public comment.
