

Unit B (North of Gunning River)

The Gunning River Hunting Unit shown on the reverse side will be open to the hunting of migratory waterfowl, rails, coots and moorhens subject to current State and Federal regulations and seasons (for NJ Coastal Hunt Zone) and the following special regulations and provisions. Hunters are restricted to designated sites [* feeder ditches are excluded from all hunting sites].

- Hunters may not use or possess more than 25 shotshells/day.
- Hunting sites are limited to one party of hunters. Sites are available on a first-come/first-served basis.
- Jump shooting is NOT permitted. Access is by boat only. No foot access.
- We require a minimum of 6 decoys per site.
- Refuge lands north of East Bay Avenue and south of the Gunning River to Log Creek Pond are closed to all public use.




B1	Conklin Island	NE side, 500 ft. either side cedar post, between site boundary signs
B2a	Wide Place	West half, inside site boundary signs
B2b	Wide Place	East half, inside site boundary signs
B3	Little Beach Pond	Entire pond
B4	Bayside, Little Beach	0.5 mile from Gulf Pt. 500 ft. either side post, between site boundary signs
B5	Gulf Point/Island	Anywhere east of site boundary signs including Gulf Island
B6	Little Beach Tide Pond	Entire pond inside site boundary posts
B7a	Unnamed Pond	Entire pond- no feeder ditches
B7b	Straddle Pond	Entire pond- no feeder ditches
B8	Oyster Pond	Entire pond- no feeder ditches
B9	Main Meadow Point	Anywhere east of site boundary signs
B10	Whalebone Point	Anywhere east of site boundary signs
B11	North Point	Anywhere south of site boundary signs
B12	Knoll Pond	Entire pond- no feeder ditches
B13	Long Pond	Entire pond- no feeder ditches
B13a	Gunning River	Between site boundary signs on north side of Gunning River
B13b	Unnamed Island	Entire island- island only
B14	Unnamed Pond	Inside site boundary signs
B15	Wall Pond	Entire pond- no feeder ditches
B16	Little Lair Pond	Entire pond- no feeder ditches
B17	Harry Pond	Eastern half, between site boundary signs
B18	Loveladies Hole	Entire pond- no feeder ditches
B19	Lower Cox Pond	North side, 500 ft. either side of site post, between site boundary signs
B20	Upper Cox Pond	North side, 500 ft. either side of site post, between site boundary signs
B21	Lower Collins Tide Pond	South side, 500 ft either side of site post, between site boundary signs
B22	Lower Collins Tide Pond	North side, 500 ft. either side of site post, between site boundary signs
B23	Upper Collins Tide Pond	South side, 500 ft. either side of site post, between site boundary signs
B24	Upper Collins Tide Pond	North side, 500 ft. either side of site post, between site boundary signs
B25a	Arnold's Pond	North half, northwest of Bridge Creek, between site boundary signs
B25b	Arnold's Pond	South half, southwest of Bridge Creek, between site boundary signs
B26	Goodes Pond	Entire pond- no feeder ditches
