## *on the Cherry Valley National Wildlife Refuge*

### *Attention Hunters: Update on Opening Process*

Cherry Valley National Wildlife Refuge is in the process of opening to hunting (big game and small game) for the Fall 2013 season, per Pennsylvania Game Commission Regulations. The opening of all new nation-wide lands to hunting is collectively announced in a Final Rule, following a 30-day public comment period on the Proposed Rule (50 CFR Part 32, 2013-2014 Refuge-Specific Hunting and Sport Fishing Regulations). The Proposed Rule was issued on September 24, 2013 and may be found online (link below). The public comment period will close on October 24, 2013, and we anticipate publication of the Final Rule no sooner than mid-November. *Until the Final Rule is issued, the refuge remains closed to hunting.*

We are dedicated to opening the refuge to hunting in 2013 and are working to issue permits at the earliest possible time. All 14 big game permits are spoken for and a wait list is in place; there are still openings for interested small game hunters. Interested hunters should contact refuge staff directly at 973-702-7266 x 10. Permits will be mailed as soon as the above-mentioned Final Rule is published. Refuge-specific regulations and maps will accompany the refuge hunting permit.

We are hopeful that hunting at Cherry Valley NWR will be approved with plenty of time left in the hunting season. However, we have no control over the timing of the rule's publication. Hunters should not expect any guarantees as to the timing in which permits can be issued. We thank you for your understanding and your cooperation in this matter.

Cherry Valley National Wildlife Refuge, established in 2009, is located in Monroe County, Pennsylvania. Public hunting is permitted on more than 3.9 million acres in Pennsylvania during specific times of the year.
