

FREE Waterfowl Hunting Course

Are you new to hunting waterfowl, or just want to learn more? Work with the Parker River National Wildlife Refuge (refuge) staff to broaden your knowledge of some of the area's common waterfowl species.

Christopher Husgen, a Federal Wildlife Officer, with close to 20 years of experience at the refuge, will discuss and describe new methods to identify ducks and will review different hunting techniques and equipment used for hunting waterfowl at the refuge and the surrounding salt marsh.

The course will conclude with a review of important waterfowl hunting laws and regulations, ensuring a positive hunting experience throughout the season.

The course is free to the public and will be held at the refuge visitor center, located at 6 Plum Island Turnpike, Newburyport, MA.
