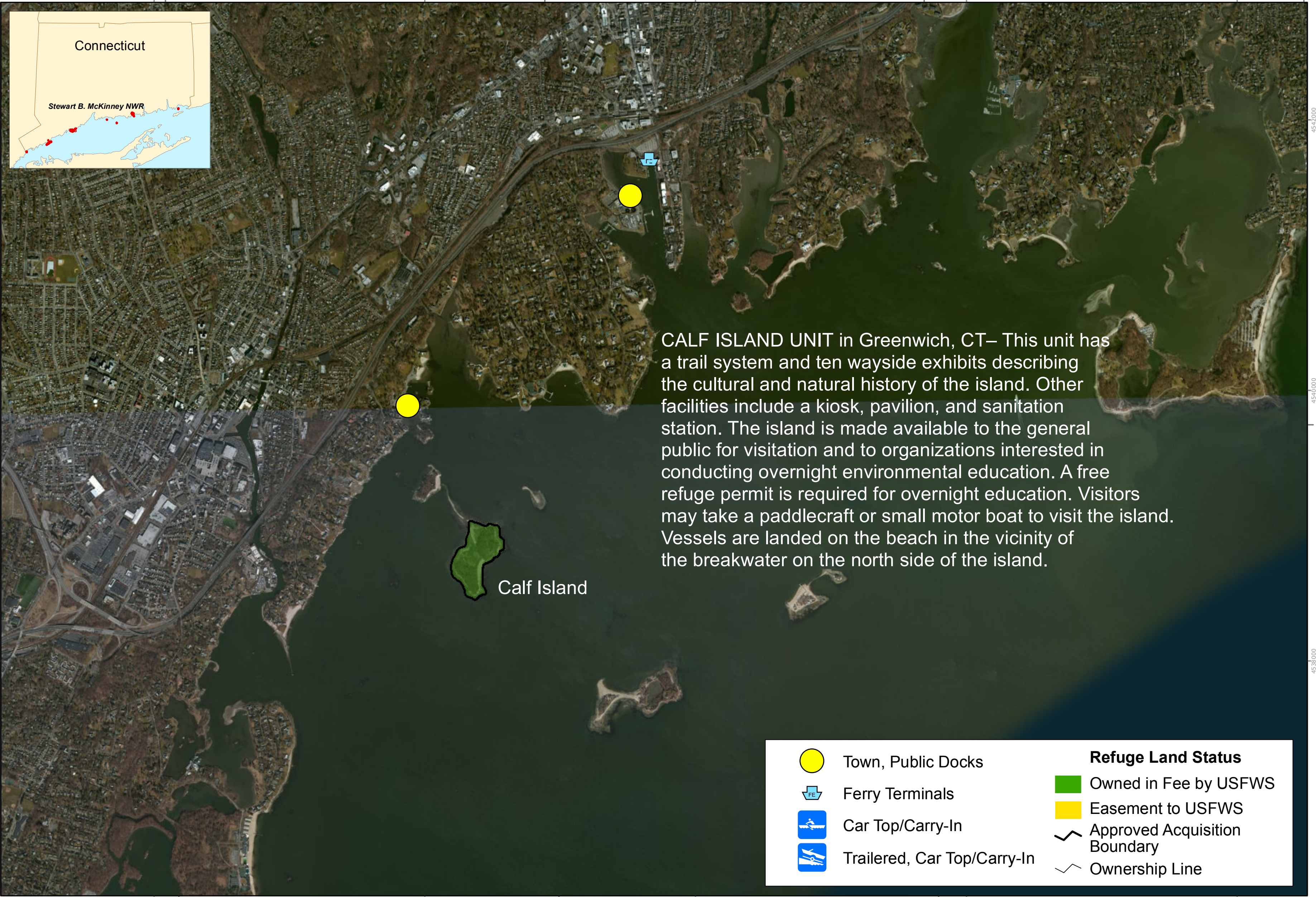
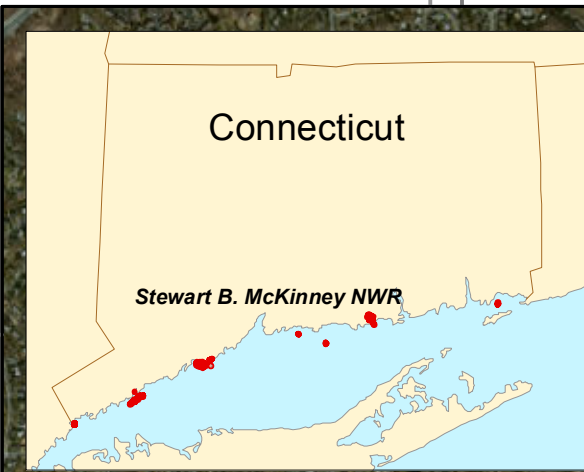

CALF ISLAND UNIT in Greenwich, CT– This unit has a trail system and ten wayside exhibits describing the cultural and natural history of the island. Other facilities include a kiosk, pavilion, and sanitation station. The island is made available to the general public for visitation and to organizations interested in conducting overnight environmental education. A free refuge permit is required for overnight education. Visitors may take a paddlecraft or small motor boat to visit the island. Vessels are landed on the beach in the vicinity of the breakwater on the north side of the island.
