


MILFORD POINT UNIT
1 Milford Point Road, Milford, CT— This unit is accessed through the Connecticut Audubon Coastal Center which provides a visitor contact station including exhibits on coastal habitat and wildlife. The Audubon Center also maintains wayside exhibits and observation platforms. On the unit itself, the Service maintains a viewing platform and access for fishing on adjacent state property.

GREAT MEADOWS MARSH, at the end of Long Beach Blvd, Stratford, CT— This unit encompasses the largest wetland in Connecticut and it has wildlife viewing trails, wayside exhibits, and viewing platforms. The public is also allowed to hunt for waterfowl on the unit during the State hunting season. A free Refuge hunting permit is required to do so.
