Blackwater NWR Announces Partial Closure of the Wildlife Drive

Blackwater National Wildlife Refuge will be closing the first section of the Wildlife Drive on Tuesday, September 8, 2015, in order to replace a water control structure near the start of the drive in Pool 1. Refuge staff estimate it will take several weeks to replace the structure and reopen the drive, depending upon the weather. During this time visitors will still be able to access a portion of the drive, free of charge, by entering through the headquarters parking lot. The area of the drive affected by the closure will be everything from the start of the drive to the Woods Trail parking lot, including the Marsh Edge trail, observation platform, and photo blind. The Woods Trail and adjoining parking lot will remain open. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause. For more information, please call 410-228-2677.
