Suckers Including: White, Northern Hog, Creek chubsucker, Lake chubsucker	None	30- daily 60- possession, in aggregate
Yellow Perch	None (if caught in non-tidal lakes or ponds)	None in lakes and ponds or upstream of them
	9 inches in nontidal streams or rivers	10- daily and in possession
