Please take notice as camps will be held in different locations in 2014. The National Wildlife Visitor Center is located on Powder Mill Road between the Baltimore Washington Parkway and Rt. 197. The North Tract is located on Rt. 198 between the Baltimore/Washington Parkway and Rt. 32.

Animal Planet

Ages 5-7, July 8th, 9th & 10th

10am-2pm

Location: National Wildlife Visitor Center

Learn the differences and similarities between different groups of animals. Discover the diversity of these animals and how each survives in their habitat. We'll explore the refuge and find these creatures in their natural habitat while playing games, doing crafts, and more.

Eco-Investigators at North Tract

Ages 11-13, July 22nd, 23rd & 24th

10am- 3pm

Location: North Tract

Investigate wildlife habitats and how plants, animals, and people interact in these environments. Explore the refuge and learn to identify different living things outside through games, observations and activities.

Nature Detectives

Ages 8-10, August, 5th, 6th & 7th

10am-2pm

Location: National Wildlife Visitor Center

Who's been here? Come learn different ways to detect animal activity as we track them through our meadows, forests, and wetlands. Learn bird calls, animal tracts, trees, and more. See how humans and animals interact in our environment and identify factors that contribute to environmental problems.



*Please note: Participants should dress for the weather, (long pants are recommended), wear sunscreen/hat, insect repellent, close toed shoes and bring water with a bag lunch that does not need to be refrigerated. Bringing an additional set of clothing and shoes is strongly encouraged. Children will likely get dirty or wet at camp.
