

Live Wolf at Patuxent



Join the Friends of Patuxent and Patuxent Research Refuge on Saturday, October 20th, at the National Wildlife Visitor Center to see a live wolf from Ironwood Wolves.

There are three different showings (10 AM, 12:30 PM, 3:00 PM).

Each showing is one hour long.

Visitors ages 13 & up will require a ticket that costs \$10.

Visitors ages 12 & under will require a ticket that costs \$5.

The one hour program includes a discussion of family life, habitat, diet, and myths and facts about wolves. Learn about the important role that wolves play in the ecosystem and why we should respect them rather than fear them.

Ironwood Wolves will be bringing their wolf ambassador, Luther.
