SP	spring	(March, April, May)
SU	summer	(June, July, August)
F	fall	(September, October, November)
W	winter	(December, January, February)
c	common	numerous in all proper habitat; very likely to see
u	uncommon	less numerous or sparsely distributed; may have to search for
r	rare	occurs regularly but very few; unlikely or lucky to see
+	casual or accidental	few or single records, usually of single birds
