FEDERAL SUBSISTENCE NOTICE 2019 Federal caribou hunt for Unit 9C remainder.



The manager of Alaska Peninsula and Becharof National Wildlife Refuges, as the Federal in-season manager, has announced a Federal subsistence caribou hunt for unit 9C remainder. The announced season will run from Aug. 10 – Oct. 10 and Nov. 1 – Feb. 29 for unit 9C remainder.

WHO CAN APPLY: Only residents of unit 9C and Egegik can apply for a registration permit.

HOW TO APPLY: Eligible hunters may apply for a permit at the USFWS office in King Salmon either in person or by telephone (see contact information below).

For unit 9C remainder, all federally qualified subsistence users from unit 9C and Egegik with a valid State Tier II permit (TC 505) or a valid Federal permit may harvest 1 bull caribou on Federal lands within unit 9C remainder.

Hunters may not add the harvest limit from Federal Subsistence and State Tier II hunt regulations together to increase the total harvest.
