

MAMMALS

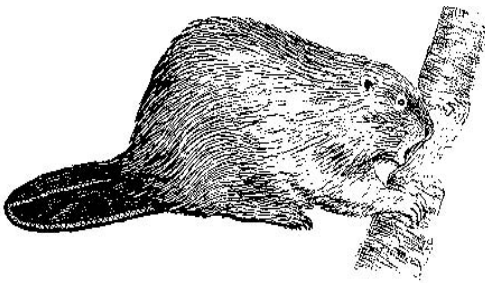
30 mammal species are known on the Innoko National Wildlife Refuge.

- Pygmy Shrew (*Sorex hoyi*)

LAGOMORPHS (hares and rabbits)

URSIDS (bears)

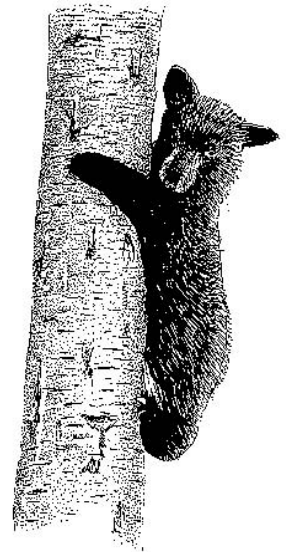
- Black Bear (*Ursus americanus*)
