

## Pincher Creek Cabin



### Description

A 14' x 16'7" foot rustic log cabin built in the summer of 2008.

### Facilities

Two bunk beds, table with benches, wood stove, broom, shovel, water bucket, fire extinguisher, and outhouse. Maximum Occupancy: 4 NOT included: running water, electricity, mattress or bedding, cooking utensils, or cut firewood. You will need to bring in enough firewood for your stay.

### Location

The cabin is located on the shore of Pincher Creek within the Chickaloon Flats. Refer to USGS map Kenai D-1. GPS: 60 degrees 54.254 and 150 degrees 12.082

### Terrain/Vegetation

The cabin is east facing within the Chickaloon Bay Tidal flats. Cabin elevation is approximately 25 feet.

### Reservations

Occupancy of Refuge cabins is by permit only (\$45 per night per party).

### Recreation Opportunities

This cabin offers seclusion, hiking, photography and waterfowl hunting. In the winter there is cross-county skiing and snowshoeing. Review Alaska Department of Fish and Game hunting and fishing regulations.

### Special Considerations

The seclusion of this cabin necessitates being prepared for emergency situations. Inclement weather may cause an unexpected extension of the trip. Bringing a personal cooking stove is recommended. Carry in enough potable water for your stay or boil surface water 5 minutes before drinking. Remember to pack out your trash.
