This is a volunteer internship program for students to work as instructor aides for Salmon Camp. This program provides opportunities for developing leadership skills and exposing youth to future career opportunities. All volunteer interns will work directly with USFWS staff and Salmon Camp instructors at all times.



Requirements for eligibility in the KRYL Program:

1. Will be in 7-12th grade in the Fall 2014 school year.
2. Can commit to working a 30 hour work week for one week out of the summer.
3. Interest in working with and mentoring youth.
4. Have a method of transportation to get to and from camp.
5. Have housing in the community of Kodiak during your program week.
