- **Pheasant Hunting**
 - Pheasant season is now closed in Oregon and California, we look forward to seeing you for the 2021 season!
- **Waterfowl Closures**
 - California
 - Canada Goose Closes Jan 10th
 - Duck season Closes Jan 13th
 - White and White Fronted goose closes Jan 15th
 - Oregon
 - Scaup closes Jan 6th
 - All Duck hunting closes Jan 24th
 - Canada goose season Closes Jan 31st
 - White and white fronted goose closes Jan 31st on refuge lands
- **Veteran and Active Military**
 - California January 16th & 17th Open to Ducks Only
 - Oregon February 6th
 - The refuge will be open to all day hunting during these hunts.
 - Veterans (as defined in Section 101 of Title 38, United States Code) and members of the Armed Forces on active duty, including members of the National Guard and Reserves on active duty (other than training), may participate. Persons participating in this special hunt must possess and present upon demand verification of eligibility to participate in this hunt. Verification includes: Veteran's ID Card and/or Military ID Card for active duty, or a State issued driver's license or Identification Card with Veteran Designation. Hunters must also have in their possession all State, Federal and Refuge licenses, stamps, validations and passes while hunting on the Refuges. Please see your State regulation booklets for specific information.
- **Tule Lake NWR**
 - **All Waterfowl Hunting units are now open to free roam Waterfowl hunting through the end of the season.**
 - Tule Lake Marsh (Sump 1A) - water levels are extremely low, and launching boats or walking in is not recommended at this time.
 - Due to fire, the second lot to the east of A Dike on the north side of the check station road has been closed to waterfowl hunting. Once issues relating to baiting have been resolved, it will be reopened.
- **Lower Klamath NWR**
 - The Oregon Straits fields are not scheduled to be flooded this season. This could change later this winter, please scout prior to field entry.
 - All marsh units continue to be dry and are closed to waterfowl hunting until further notice.

We understand this is a frustrating season for everyone, please be patient as we are doing the best we can to offer a quality hunting experience in difficult times.
