

Summer Job Announcement – Youth Conservation Corps Crew

Become a part of this summer's residential work/education program at Ruby Lake National Wildlife Refuge. Crew members will participate in refuge resource projects such as building maintenance, trail maintenance and fence removal with additional time spent on resource education. After work the crew will share household responsibilities and outdoor recreational pursuits such as hiking, fishing, rock climbing, or playing volleyball.

Dates: June 12 – August 5, 2016 (8 wks). July 4th (Monday) is a federal holiday, and the crew will work at the Angel Lake Fishing Derby on July 16th (Saturday) resulting in a 3 day weekend for 4th of July and a one day weekend July 17th. Applicants must commit to the entire season.



Schedule: Residential program Mon. – Fri. 7:00am – 3.30 pm with weekends off at home.

Crew: Young men and women, ages 15 – 18yrs. *(must be 15 and not turn 19 while enrolled)*

Pay: \$8.25/hr (current NV minimum wage)

Eligibility: Permanent U.S. resident; a Social Security number, signed parent/guardian permission. More information is on the application form.
